

## Draw a Lincoln Castle Sunset



1. Tape down your paper so it doesn't slip.



You will need:

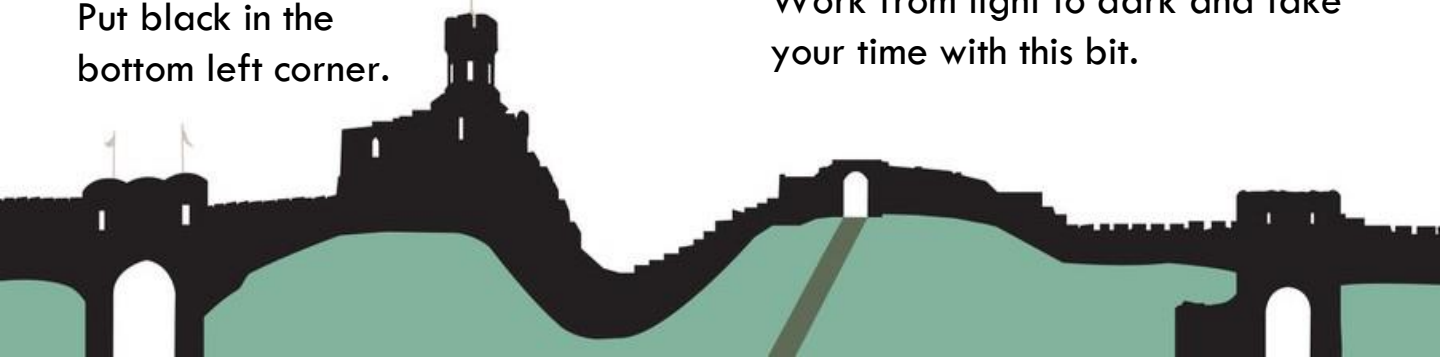
- Paper
- Masking tape
- Oil or chalk pastels
- Cotton wool or tissue
- A black pencil

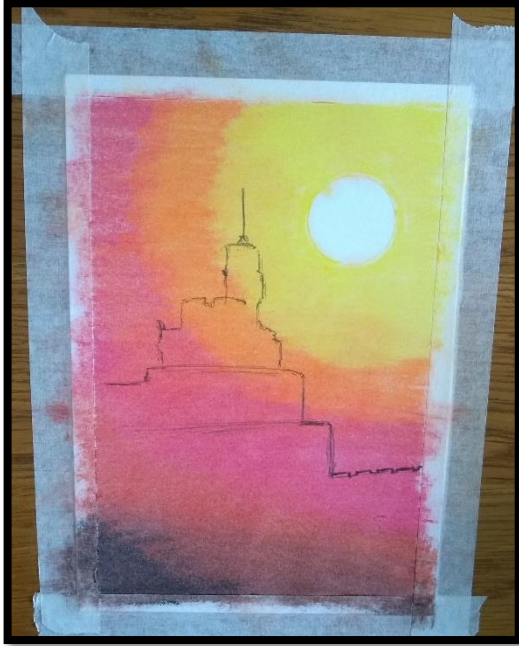


2. Use yellow, orange, red and brown to make a sunset scene. Leave a white circle for the sun. Put black in the bottom left corner.



3. Rub with a cotton make up pad to blend your colours together. Work from light to dark and take your time with this bit.





4. Using black pencil draw an outline of Lincoln Castle. Draw from memory or use a photo to help you. The silhouette on the bottom of this page might help!



5. Colour in your outline with black oil pastel. Blend it with a fresh cotton pad. Use black pencil to add details. And finally, gently remove the masking tape.
